

Here is the proper way to attach the stirrups and the closing of the leather with the coverlet. Notice that the tongue of the buckle is on the inside as is the tail of the leather. If you find that the “tail” is too long, you can then “cut off” what you will not need.



After the leather is adjusted to the proper length, you slide the coverlet down over the buckle until it is completely hidden.
